**Author/Editor** (always)

**Title** (always)

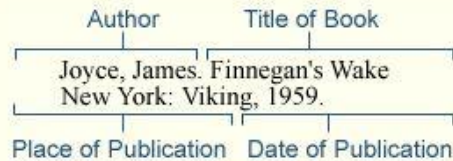
**Publisher or Place of Publication** (book usually but sometimes web sources)

**Date(s)** - when was it put in print or on the web? **Retrieved** date (when you looked at it)

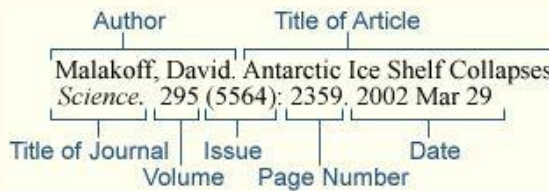
## Parts of a Citation

As you do your research, keep a list of your sources--books, periodicals, and the Web. Below is the type of information you need to write down from a citation with each of its important parts labeled:

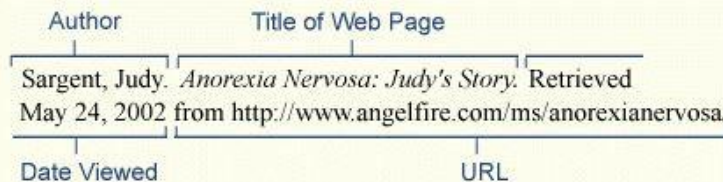
### For a book:
