The district has purchased the rights for all students to access Office 365, a suite of online programs that all automatically save on cloud storage so you will never lose work again and can update from any device anywhere with internet access. Go to office.com and sign in using your student#@sd79.bc.ca (so 123456@sd79.bc.ca) and the password is the same as your wifi ("welcome" if you haven't changed it).
