EARHTQUAKE DRILL

Please remind your students that we live in a subduction zone and a major earthquake could happen here at any time.

Procedure:

If indoors:

- ◆ If the Principal/VP sounds an earthquake signal or if you see or feel signs of an earthquake (the ground shaking, hanging objects swaying, objects wobbling on shelves):
 - Take cover immediately under desks, tables or other heavy furniture
 - Drop, cover and hold on
 - Turn away from windows
 - If heavy furniture is not available, crouch against an interior wall
 - Stay away from windows, light fixtures and suspended objects
 - Remain calm, reassuring students by speaking and giving instructions in a firm, calm voice
 - When the quake is over, count to 60 and then follow the Evacuation Procedure to designated assembly area
 - Remain outside the building until it has been inspected and declared safe by authorized personnel
