Last day – of Quarter 2 is January 28th. Quarter 3 begins on Feb. 1st.

Grade 10s - Provincial assessments are approaching. All grade 10 students who have completed an English course in Q 1 or Q2 will be sitting for their Literacy 10 Assessment.

All grade 10 students who have completed a Math course in Q1 or Q2 will be sitting for their Numeracy 10 Assessment.

Any grade 12 student in grade 12 who has not yet written their Numeracy assessment will be sitting for their Numeracy Assessment.

Completion of these assessments is a graduation requirement.

The assessments run January 25-29th. The 29th is an "I" day as term ends the 28th. Assessments will run this day as well.

This is a busy week for everyone. Be aware you may have two assessments to complete during the week. We will send the schedule of students registered to write to all teachers of grade 10s on Monday January 11. The schedule will also be posted on the STUDENT INFORMATION BOARD. Students must check your date and time.
