Dear Parent/Guardians,

ALL students wanting transportation services for the 2023-24 school year MUST register for busing! Students who have not obtained their passes prior to September 11, 2023 may be denied ridership

Just a reminder that it is time to register your students for busing for the 2023/2024 school year. Registration is from May 1st to 31st. If you have already registered your student(s) during this month, thank you!

To those who have not yet registered, please visit our School District [website](#) for fillable or printable registration forms.

Registration forms can also be picked up at District schools or at the Transportation Office.

Registration after May 31, 2023 deadline could take 15 days or more depending on the volume of registrations received. Parents will need to make alternate arrangements until registrations have been processed and an email to the parent/guardian has been received.
