The Municipality of North Cowichan Tom Walker Forest Legacy Scholarship and Bursaries will be awarded to a secondary school graduate who is a resident of North Cowichan. The applicant must be enrolled in a post-secondary institute such as a technical school, College or University enrolled in a 1st year program. While all students are encouraged to apply, preference will be given to students who are enrolled in science related studies such as forestry, environmental, fisheries, hydrology, geotechnical etc. In the absence of an applicant pursuing a science related field, the scholarship and bursaries will be awarded based on a scoring system that evaluates the applicant's submission as per the requirements outlined above.

These awards are funded from revenues derived from the Municipal Forest Reserve through the Municipal Forestry Program.

The Municipality will award the scholarship and two bursaries directly to the winners upon proof of enrollment in the post-secondary institution.
