Parent Portal- Did you know you are able to check attendance, class schedules, teachers and send emails to teachers of your student in the parent portal? Lately we have had a few issues with the program sending out parent notifications of missed classes. We want to make sure you knew there was another way to view attendance records.

Login into parent portal at https://myeducation.gov.bc.ca/aspen/logon.do (if you require assistance please email fkssparentportal@sd79.bc.ca).

1. Once in, **For Attendance**- go to Academics top tab, select your student (if you have more than one student here)

Attendance left side tab- classes will then show at top in blue.

The arrow on top right of page will scroll the different classes.

AE= Absent excused (from a parent/guardian)

- 2. For Classes- Academics top tab, classes will pop up and show class, terms, and teacher.
- 3. **To send email-** If you go to options box (while classes are open on screen), select send email, and select what teachers you want to send to.
