### • President's Report & Introduction

- Request from a parent to hold our meetings via Zoom – Nicole will look into setting up the Zoom portion of the meetings for us.

Concerns of Graffiti, staff have graffiti wipes, and if it is brought to their attention they will use the wipes right away. If the wipes don't work then further steps will be taken. Staff does exterior loops in the morning to check around the building, and check washrooms every morning. Operations will prioritize graffiti as well as other items, for the items that are prioritized they will tend to with a phone call not have to wait for a work order.

Breakfast Program – PAC used to help fund the breakfast program, but Nourish Cowichan is now providing this program. Students can access these items at room 158, and in the office both the morning, and lunch time. There is no discrimination, anyone can access this. Staff/advisors and EA's are aware of students who are in need, but perhaps not all that are in need. There are also hamper pick-ups for those students/families in need. Advisors read the morning news breaker (announcements) and it this program is advertised in that source.

Bathroom incidents were a concern last year and have been a concern at the beginning of this year - students not wanting to use the bathrooms out of fear, vandalism happening and vaping happening. Staff do random walk throughs. Currently 2 downstairs bathrooms in the morning are being used as a girls hangout, and staff are walking through and shooing them out. Some vaping happening in the bathrooms. If student is caught vaping, they are sent home. Dance room has been opened up for make up in the mornings, this has helped with the congregating in the girls bathroom. The vandalism has improved in the boys bathrooms as of late.

Kelsey Alumni Bus – How many children does this benefit overall? Going back to September 2019, used 88 times, it was used for 48 co-ed events, 35 girls events and 14 boys events.

Keeping in mind we experienced two years of Covid. The upcoming years the usage will likely be greater

Lizzie Motioned to give the FKSS Alumni Association \$2500.00 from the 2022/2023 school year budget with confirmation of our bank balance, for their maintenance. Jennifer Seconded. Motion carried.

We will have to finalize our budget for 2023/2024 School year and decide if continuing to provide \$5000.00 per school year for the maintenance of the FKSS Alumni Bus can be part of our budget.

### • Principal's / Vice Principal's Reports and Funding Requests

School Dance December 7<sup>th</sup>. Tickets in advance, not being sold at the door. Band Concert maybe beginning in December, waiting on confirmation from the band teacher. Poetry/Arts night December 8<sup>th</sup>. Volleyball and Cross Country wrapping up. Basketball starting up. Perhaps needing a parent education piece around how teachers assess the students. How important it is for students to be in attendance. Reviewing with parents the proficiency scale, and the graduation program, that begins in Grade 10. Discussions have been had about bringing some parents of grads in to chat with parents of our graduating class about graduation and scholarships etc.

Anti-Vaping campaign. Student led, with support from admin/staff. Posters, Guest speakers, videos. Nicole is meeting with the student group and they are contacting VIHA about having some guest speakers come in.

Department Heads meeting – What are some meaningful way to bring parents in to be part of the school community. Some ideas – Breakfast Program, Pizza Day, help with set up for assemblies, field trip helpers.

Request for funding from the Field Hockey Coach for Field hockey turf rental fee - \$450.00 requested from team.
