Remembrance Day Stat Holiday – Please note that there is no school Monday, November 13th.

Remembrance Day Legion Contests are open to all students! You can submit a video, poster, or literary entry on the theme of Remembrance with a Canadian focus. The video must be between 30 seconds and 2 minutes in English, French or both (with correct copyright citations). Posters must be no larger than 56cm x 71cm and there are two categories of colour or black and white. Literary entries must not exceed the word limit of the level you are entering, senior - no more than 800 words or poetry of not more than 32 lines, intermediate - no more than 500 words or poetry of not more than 32 lines, junior - no more than 350 words or poetry of not more than 32 lines. Deadline is your entry in the front office by November 17th, 2023.
