

GENERAL INFORMATION:

VIRTUAL PRESENTATION: Establishing Respectful Relationships and Consent in Our Communities

Students in Grades 9 through 12, district-wide, will be watching a virtual presentation by provincial organization Safer Schools Together. Students will watch this presentation with their C block teachers one day next week (the teacher will determine which day will work best for the class).

In this session, the topics of consent and the dynamics of gender-based violence are explored. The Safer Schools trainers present information on the current state of gender relations in both the physical and digital landscapes as well as the potential for exploitation within these relationships. Throughout the session, Safer Schools trainers provide students with tips and tools to help them navigate and grow in these environments.

The presentations are one hour Zoom sessions that are designed for classes or groups of classes. A suggestion to have 20-30 minutes post presentation for teacher lead discussion with the class group and that school Counsellors are involved in the planning.

Safer Schools Together is a partner agency of the BC Ministry of Education and Childcare as they provide both prevention and educational services to schools.

Students will learn:

- What defines consent?
- The dynamics of gender-based violence
- An overview of worrisome content and how to manage exposure on popular social media and gaming platforms
- The different types of bullying and cyberbullying relationships
- The consequences of sending/receiving intimate images and videos
- The pathway to sextortion and human trafficking. Important signs to look for
- The importance of checking in on our mental health and strategies for success
- An anonymous student reporting tool that can help you and your friends stay safe both online and offline

Safer Schools offered this session for Parents/Guardians via Zoom in November and will again be offering sessions in January and February 2024.
