Please also submit the following documents:

- proof of acceptance into a post-secondary institution if available or details of your post-secondary institution of interest
- your transcript
- 2 letters of reference from either employment, volunteering and/or teacher
- a copy of your resume

The recipient must access the Bursary within two academic years of graduation from Frances Kelsey and you must provide proof of registration into your post-secondary institution

If a Bursary is unclaimed after two years, the funds return to the general funds of the PAC.
