Semester End Details

- Wednesday, January 25 Last regular day of Semester 1 classes (Grades 8 through 12). Wed, Jan 25 is also an Early Dismissal Day (1:15 PM). This day is also a 2-Hour early dismissal
- Thursday, January 26 Learning Review Day (formerly known as "I" Day). This is a day where all teachers are available to all students, but only those students who need to complete work in order to be successful need to attend. This includes all grades (8-12). There will be no regular classes on this day.

Semester End Details – Con't

- Friday, January 27 Turn Around Day. This is a day where teachers are preparing for Semester 2 courses. There are NO SCHEDULED CLASSES on the 27th, and all students will remain at home.

Winter Activity Day

Your child will have an opportunity to participate in one of the following activities on Winter Activity Day. There is no required curriculum content or assessment attached to these field trips. Permission slips and further details will be given out at meetings for each activity. Please note that an activity may be cancelled due to lack of interest. This is a regular school day. Those students not participating in a field trip will be able to work under teacher supervision. School bus service will be at normal times.

Permissions Forms will be provided during long advisor on January 20, 2023.

SKIING (Mt. Washington – Grades 8-12)

Leave Kelsey at 6:00 a.m. using Wilson Chartered buses. Arrive at Mt. Washington just after 8:00 a.m. Ski until 3:00 p.m. Leave Mt. Washington by 3:30 p.m. and arrive at Kelsey between 6:00 and 6:30 p.m. Cost will range from \$80 (own equipment and lift ticket) to \$145. Helmets are mandatory and are included in the cost.

Winter Activity Day — Con't

SNOWBOARDING (Mt. Washington – Grades 8-12)

Leave Kelsey at 6:00 a.m. using Wilson Chartered. Arrive at Mt. Washington just after 8:00 a.m. Snowboard until 3:00 p.m. Leave Mt. Washington by 3:30 p.m. and arrive at Kelsey between 6:00 and 6:30 p.m. Cost will be range from \$80 (own equipment and lift ticket) to \$145. Helmets and wrist guards are mandatory and are included in the cost.

SNOWSHOEING/TUBING (Mt. Washington – Grades 8-12)

Leave Kelsey at 6:00 a.m. using Wilson Chartered buses. Arrive at Mt. Washington just after 8:00 a.m. Snowshoe for two hours. Tube for one hour after lunch. Leave Mt. Washington by 3:30 p.m. and arrive at Kelsey between 6:00 and 6:30 p.m. The estimated cost is \$118.00.

BOWLING, SWIMMING, MOVIE (Duncan – Grades 8-9)

Students will be travelling by school bus (9:10 a.m.) to Duncan where they will participate in each of the activities listed above. Return to school for a movie. Cost is approximately \$20.

Vancouver SCIENCE WORLD (Grades 8-9)

Leave Kelsey by 6:40 a.m. to catch the 8:25 a.m. sailing at Nanaimo. Travel by charter bus to Science World. Opportunity to view exhibits for about 2 hours. Leave by 1:45 p.m. to catch the 3:45 p.m. sailing back. Arrive back at Kelsey between 6:15 and 6:30p.m. The cost will be approximately \$67.


Find Your Fit BC is coming to FKSS

• Ms. Kaye's Foods Class made home made perogies this week, and gave them an enthusiastic thumbs up!












Flash Mob
