SCHOOL SUPPLIES...

SCHOOL FEES...

Student Activity Fees: Students are charged a yearly \$25 fee that helps defray the costs of:

Guest presentations, school events, special assemblies, intramurals, and agenda books.

Textbook Deposit: A one-time \$25 deposit is charged to all Gr. 8 students and any new students. If no books are lost or damaged, this deposit will be returned when the student leaves Kelsey, or it will offset the cost graduation expenses.

If you haven't already done so, please follow these instructions to create your School Cash Online account any time after August 30th. Please note that this is the preferred method of payment.
