

From the Principal:

Learning updates for all students will be printed and handed out to students in advisor on this morning. As well, the parent portal is now open for those who would like to view the Learning Update online. Please see instructions below for accessing the parent portal.

The My Education BC Parent Portal provides parent/guardians online access to student demographic and academic information. Schools and teachers are able to use the portal to communicate in a variety of ways, including distribution of Learning Updates (report cards) and Grad Status Updates for grades 10-12, access to gradebook assignments (please check with individual teachers if gradebook is used for their class), and student information such as attendance and schedule. This information is accessible for the parent/guardian 24/7 without having to contact the school.

Beginning in fall 2026:

- Horatio Alger Canadian Scholarships and Horatio Alger Québec Scholarships (170 scholarships awarded per year) will double to \$10,000 per student, up from \$5,000.
- National Entrepreneurial Scholarships (10 scholarships awarded per year) will increase to \$25,000 per student, up from \$10,000.
