The account is deleted sometime in the first two weeks of July. If you have resumes, cover letters, any assignments you want to keep for post-secondary reference, etc., you need to transfer them to a personal account. As well, ensure if you have given your school email as a contact to anyone or used it for sign in to other accounts, that you reset to a personal one as you will not be able to access it to reset passwords.
