# Programs for Next Year:

**Soft Landing program:** Most suited for students who are unsuccessful due to the secondary school structure (4 block timetable and semester system). May have anxiety/mental health concerns but do not have outward facing negative behaviors, <u>low to no attendance</u>: A and B are electives and C and D are core subjects.

**Pre-employment Program** (with Resource teacher for blocks C and D only, linear literacy and numeracy programming, grade appropriate, *are* possibly capable of full or adult dogwood) \*\* attend electives (or other classes) for A and B.

**Life Skills Program** (Blocks A and B, room 158, modified programs, need support with communication)

Funding request attached from Adrien Achurch for a pop up canopy shelter. This would be used for sporting events, extracurricular events and more. He is requesting \$300.00 to purchase a canopy.

Toni makes a motion to support the request in the amount of \$300.00 to purchase a canopy. Jennifer Seconded. All in Favour. Motion Passed.

We also discussed the possibility of having the canopy branded with FKSS Logo etc. or the possibility of funding a couple of FKSS Banners that could be hung across the canopy at events. Mr. Van der linden will discuss with staff if they feel this would be useful for extra curricular events, and we will wait to see a new funding request.

### • Old Business -

Jennifer with Myra Jean who is part of student parliament about the survey with regards to what areas of the school are too hot or too cold. The survey has not yet been done. Jennifer will help put together a survey. After this survey is complete it will be sent to the district for consideration for when they may need to partition some of the larger classrooms, or for where improvements can be made for ventilation and airflow.

Indoor Redesign update (Jennifer) and discussion item regarding more funding tabled from last meeting.

We had a lengthy discussion about the Phase 1 of the indoor redesign project. The PAC initially approved (May 2024) to give \$6000.00 towards Phase 1 of the indoor redesign project. At the April meeting, a request was made to increase this cost to \$14,000. Today we received an official quote for the front entrance way. The amount was a significant increase ranging from \$20,000-\$28,000. Depending on whether we cut out some of the items. The items would be two large seating benches, some tables, and plants. The furniture will be vinyl and is a type of furniture used in hospitals, and airports. PAC's concern at this time is the cost, and longevity of these items. Teenagers can be very careless, and disrespectful to common property. Mr. Van der linden also expressed concerns about it getting ruined in a short amount of time. Jennifer was going to go back to the company with our concerns and see if they had alternative options for a lesser amount than \$20,000.
