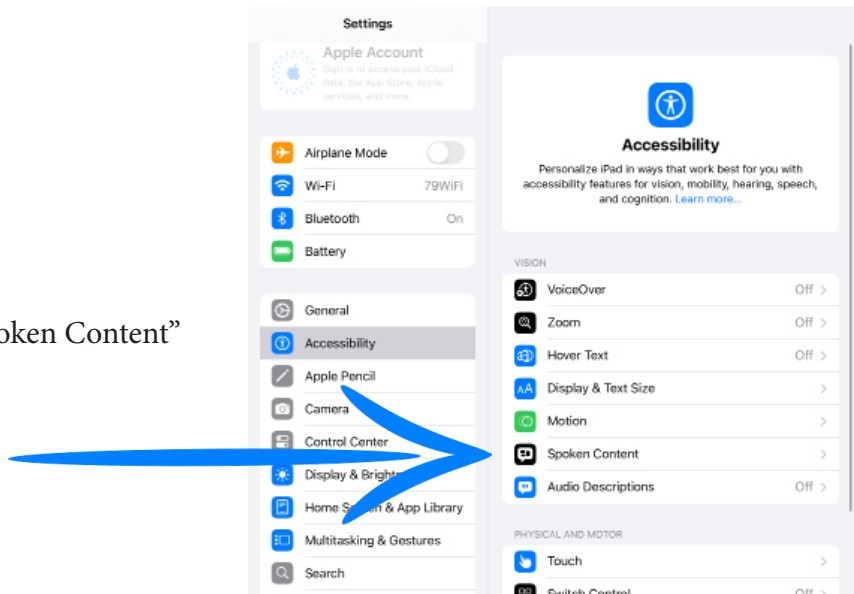
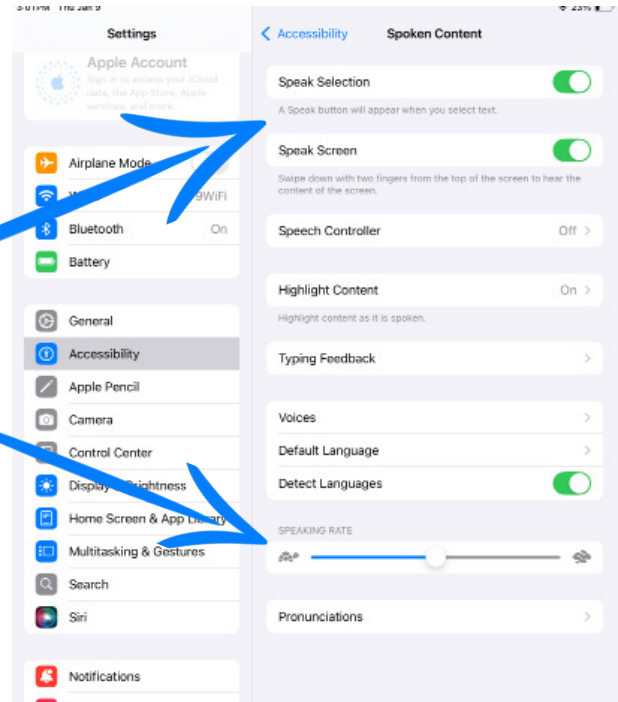


How to set an iPad to Read Aloud

1. Open the “Settings” for the iPad.
2. Click on “Accessibility”
3. Look in right column and click on “Spoken Content”



4. Still in right column, toggle on “Speak Selection”
5. Toggle on “Speak Screen” as well
6. Optional: Toggle on “Highlight Content” if you want the words being read aloud to also highlight as read
7. You also have options on speaking speed, languages, etc. in this area



8. Open the document or page you want and use two fingers to swipe down from the top of the iPad to the bottom.
9. You should see a menu bar in the middle of the page that will control speed, pausing, etc.. It may minimize but you should always see an arrow on the left side of the page to expand it again

Have iPad speak onscreen text

1. Go to Settings > Accessibility > Spoken Content.

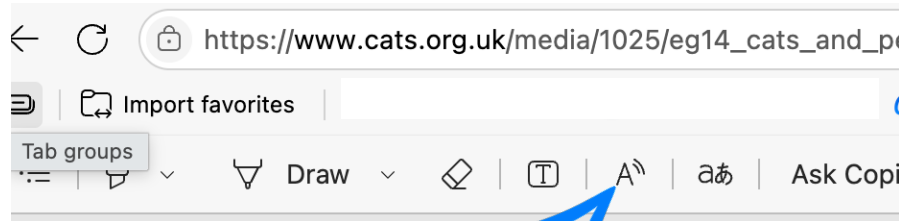
2. Turn on any of the following:

- **Speak Selection:** Have iPad speak the text you select.
 - **Speak Screen:** Turn on Speak Screen to have iPad speak the content of the screen. Turn on Highlight Content to have words or sentences highlighted as iPad reads them out loud.
 - **Typing Feedback options:** As you type, have iPad speak character by character, word by word, and more.
3. Do any of the following:
- **Hear selected text (if you turned on Speak Selection):** Select the text you want spoken, then tap Speak.

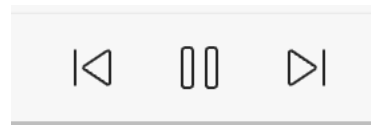


How to Read Aloud using Edge

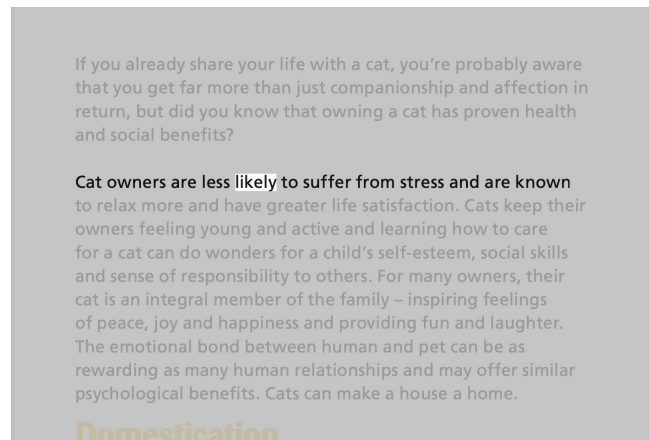
1. Open the PDF in the Edge browser
2. Look for the toolbar on the left hand side
3. The A with the two curved lines is read aloud.



4. When you click the button, it begins to read and the pause/beg/end buttons are top centre of the PDF



5. The text goes gray and highlights what is being read



6. On the right hand side, you have voice and speed options
