- demonstrates financial need
- is eligible to graduate from SD 79 in the year of application or within the last 12 months (please include est. final marks)
- demonstrates a keen interest in gardening and related fields
- volunteers or works in a job related to plants

Please apply by submitting the attached application form, your resume with two letters of reference, and a personal essay complete with your goals and reasons for choosing your post secondary program.

Proof of enrolment at an accredited Canadian post secondary institution is required before receiving the bursary.

Awarded funds are held in trust. If a recipient has not used the bursary within two years of the award, funds revert back to the Mill Bay Garden Club.
