Interior Design Update: Submitted by Jennifer Thom

Update: Indoor redesign of front entrance.

July-August 2025: Following PAC feedback to find more durable seating for the front entrance area inside the school at a price point less than \$20K, a proposed furniture option was shared with PAC in July, principal Kevin van der Linden and teacher Lisa Huck in August.

September 2025: Kevin van der Linden and teacher Lisa Huck shared that staff have decided that the school will purchase stools for Dome area and not move forward with interior redesign of the entrance and Dome area. The staff feel that there is sufficient furniture for students. Jennifer will work with students to identify a new "sense of place" project that will benefit all FKSS students and with which the PAC funds (\$9K) that have been set aside can be used.

SUMMARY TIMELINE FOR INDOOR REDESIGN

May/June 2024: Students (various grade levels) enrolled in Lisa Huck's class, which included an interior design component, identified the front entrance as a place where Grade 8 and 9 students gathered and where seating could provide a social place for the students. As well, furniture would create better traffic flow when entering and exiting the school.

Additional designs were generated by students for furnishing the Dome as two distinct areas to address multiple purposes—e.g., studying, eating, socializing, improving traffic flow.

September 2024 - June 2025:

Jennifer, Lisa, students, and administrators meet, review furniture designs, and plan for furnishing the front entrance inside the school.

June 2025: Jennifer shares proposed furniture at PAC meeting (below). Feedback from PAC: more durable furniture options and lower price tag (i.e., less than \$20K)





June-July 2025:

Jennifer works with furniture consultant (same consultant for Quw'utsun Secondary School) to find alternate options according to PAC feedback while maintaining student designed "curvilinear look" for overall arrangement of furniture and staying with colours from the Photographic Journeys installation.

July 8, 2025:

Jennifer shares alternative furniture and two possible funding options with PAC:



1. Go with original plan for PAC to fund \$9K for the project and FKSS cost-share for the remaining cost \$5800 + up to \$1200 for plants for the front entrance area; and in addition to the stools (\$2000) that FKSS has already ordered for the Dome.

2. If PAC wishes to allocate more funds to decrease the bank balance, PAC could fund \$15K (seating and table furniture) and additionally, up to \$1200 (plants) for the project. Next year, PAC would, at most, contribute a maximum of \$1800 for the second phase of the Dome redesign if the idea of \$9K for future phases is desired.
