

STUDENTS:

As we prepare for the new semester, starting Monday January 26, 2026, we want to outline the procedures for student course change requests. Students in Grade 9-12 will pick up their semester 2 courses in their **Q Block December 3, 2025**. Information will be posted on the counselling door. Counsellors will be working on the course change request in the following order:

Grade 12- Dec 8

Grade 10 & 11- Dec 9 & 10

Grade 9- Dec 11

For the next couple weeks, the Interact Club is hosting a holiday food drive to help ease food insecurity in the community. All donations will go directly to the local CMS Food Bank.

High-need items include canned meats and fish, protein-rich foods, beef stew, chili, peanut butter, canned fruits and vegetables, instant potatoes, cereal, rice, pasta and sauce, boxed meals, and hearty soups. The CMS Food Bank is also collecting personal care products such as shampoo, deodorant, soap, diapers, feminine hygiene products, toothpaste, and toilet paper.

There will be boxes in the main office and counselling office as well as some classrooms for donations.

Every contribution, big or small, helps the community, making sure members can enjoy a warm, dignified, and hopeful holiday season.

For the next two weeks on Monday and Tuesday the Interact Club will be selling Holiday Candy Grams in the dome at lunch! For just \$2, a candy cane and holiday song will be delivered to the student (or teacher) of your choice! This will occur on December 15th and 16th during D-block. Come help spread holiday cheer!

The Spirit and Events Committee will be hosting a Winter Dance on December 11 from 6-8 PM. Purchase your tickets for \$5 in the dome during lunch or on SchoolCash Online until December 10. The theme for the dance is Snowball. There will be two "Snow Royalty" crowns awarded to students that best represent Kelsey's values - community, connection, and compassion. Students can be nominated at the ticket table in the dome during lunch until December 10. Voting will take place at the door before students enter the dance. During the dance, the Spirit and Events committee will count the votes, and the Snow Royalty crowns will be awarded. Snow Royalty winners MUST be present at the dance to be crowned.
