A suggestion was made to the Leadership group to get in touch with a gentleman named Kyle Ridley - who offers DJ services. They have confirmed Kyle for the dance at a cost of \$300.00

The leadership group is looking for parent volunteers - 5:30-7 or 7-8:30.

A bylaw committee being formed to redo the bylaws of DPAC Transportation policy is being updated. The school district has budgeted money to hire 12 new EA's - All Schools will be getting an AED - DPAC does have some money for Parent Education Sessions

And we can repost bylaws again once updated.

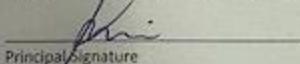

Thank you for the consideration for my funding request.

Our club is in redevelopment as I have recently returned after two years away .
